Juan Manuel MARMOL
Oscar Ramon MOREAU
Fidel AGUIRRE
Rogelio MENESES Ruiz

They left on two small aircraft which may have landed on either side of the Guatemalan-Honduran border.

- 2. The following persons left for El Salvador from Guatemala to kidnap Colonel CASTILLO's wife, who is believed to be in El Salvador:
