Via Java Pacific Lines.

RE: LINC 2273; C J1524

1. The leads regarding this attempted shipment have been followed up to the extent of our current capability. Customs in N.Y. and Dun & Bradstreet had no information in addition to what had been reported in C J1524.

2. KUJUMP was requested to make a special investigation, and reports as follows:

a. We have been informed that Java Pacific Lines and Nedlloyd Lines of Amsterdam, Holland operate vessels between the US and Canadian ports to the Mediterranean, Persian Gulf, India and Pakistan.

b. Both of these lines are with the Royal Netherlands Steamship Company which, among other companies, is under British control through Funch, Edye & Company Inc., of 25 Broadway, New York City.

c. We have obtained the following names of ships operated by the Royal Netherlands Steamship Company. We do not know if they operate others:
