OFFICERS CORPS OBVIOUSLY TORN BETWEEN CONFLICTING LOYALTIES (OFFICERS SUBMITTING WRITTEN QUESTIONNAIRES TO PRESIDENT THIS WEEK) AND FORTHRIGHT DECLARATION U.S. INTENTIONS MAY SPARKPLUG OPPOSITION.
