1. The referenced cable gives a guidance, but it does not provide any pegs for the themes indicated. Presumably local pegs will be picked up where the guidances are used. However, Lincoln might want to manufacture some pegs for further exploitation both within the regional command, which would be picked up and exploited, and outside of it too.

2. Any statements made by Guatemalan officials to the effect that the Communist-supplied arms are only those needed to maintain internal order might be used to plug the theme in para 2a of the referenced cable. The line could be "The purpose of the Communist-supplied arms is said to be for use on Guatemalans—probably to subjugate population to Communist will."
