- on 6 May 1954, he was met by a representative I the latter took KEMPTON's flight bag, containing twelve tapes, and accompanied him to the waiting room. From there the C I representative carried the bag
- 2. When KERPION's suitcase was brought in and he approached the customs official, the latter asked, "where is the bag you were carrying when you got off the plane?" - 5. Three policemen who were on duty at the airport then entered. They agreed with the \_\_\_\_\_\_ I man that they had no right to search his car, stating that it was a matter that would have to be settled by the customs officials.
