1. An investigation of the subject's activities in Tegucigalpa provides nothing which would serve to confirm the suspicion of [] that the subject is a double agent. In the personal opinion of CALLIGERIS [] is a loyal fighter against Communism, although it is admitted that he may be somewhat of a leftist.

2. CALLIGERIS was able to provide no information concerning the disappearance of the subject from Mexico City. He stated that [] had offered his services wherever they were needed. [] has stated that he knows many people who own land along the border (it was not specified which border), who he felt might cooperate in the cause.
