## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: MT/7 Task Progress Report for Week 8 March - 14 March incl.

- 1. CAT pilots held Miami from 6 March to 11 March waiting WHD approval of AMD proposed pay and reimbursement of these sterile air crew members. Concurrance received via telephone 10 March (see Memo for the Record dated 11 March, subject Air Operations). Each air crew member advanced additional (total for Jocover additional expenses, travel, and per diem. Pilots departed Miami via Pan American for Havana.
- 3. CAT pilots finance report for the record (refer progress report for week 1 March 7 March): During the briefing of the CAT pilots on 7 March, and the following statement to the CAT pilots: "AMD Headquarters has told the CAT pilots that all their expenses incurred while in Miami would be paid by the Company."
