1. This information on the situation in WSBURNT and on operational difficulties being experienced by LIONIZER was furnished by LIBETHENITE-4. Identities are as given in reference (a):

## a. Distribution of bulletin

A friendly WSBURNT priest, who was unwilling to reveal his name to LIONIZER, has requested that a quantity of the back issues and all future issues of the bulletin be sent directly to the Archbishopric of WSBURNT. The back issues and ten copies of each current issue are now being sent to that addressee;

## b. Payment to Identity Q

Pursuant to Headquarters authorization of reference (e), paragraph IF, the first payment of [ ] U.S. has been made to this individual; it was hand-carried from [ ] by the sister of Identity A, who was to deliver it to the recipient. No message in any form has been received by LIONIZER acknowledging delivery or receipt of the money;

## c. Shipment of bulk propaganda

When Identity F was in **L**, he agreed to a decision to pick up bulk propaganda from Identity D and to transport it by air to Identity B



for distribution. However, follow-up cables and messages from LIBETHENITE-4 have elicited no answer. Identity A, in a message to LIBETHENITE-4, has stated that he has tried to talk to Identity F a dozen times to no avail. Identity A therefore suggests that an arrangement be made to ship the material through Identity X (of this dispatch) by sea to Identity Y (of this dispatch), a friend of Identity A and B. Details have not been planned, and Headquarters approval is requested before any steps are taken.

- d. It has been reported to LIBETHENITE-4 (the source is being ascertained), that there exists in WSBURNT an organization connected with the ODYOKE Embassy which is trying to incite elements of the WSBURNT army to rise against the government, and that there is a rumor that the WSBURNT President has deposited funds in Switzerland, to which country he is also supposed to have sent his family a short time ago.
- 2. Local press clippings are forwarded under separate pouch for Head-quarters information. Only one copy of each clipping is available at this date and it is suggested that Headquarters forward these clippings to LINCOLN following Headquarters review. In the future, two sets of clippings will be furnished.
