## Biographic Sketches of Quatemalan Communists

- 1. With reference to the memorandum prepared at Headquarters on 25 September 1953, setting forth the priority targets of this station, there are attached our list of the twenty-eight (28) communists and pro-communists considered most dangerous and resumes of the activities of twelve (12) of these individuals.
- 2. The osalid copies were prepared by an officer of this Embassy in connection with a report on communism in Guatemala, forwarded to the Department of State with Despatch No. 308 of 9 October 1953, which is available to Headquarters. Most of the information contained therein was obtained from the files of this station, and it is felt that they are adequate and complete without being rewritten by us.
- 3. Much of the information of biographic and political nature is a matter of public record. This station is in the process of gathering data which might be used for character assassination purposes, and this will be forwarded shortly.
- 4. This station is preparing reports of both types on the remaining sixteen (16) individuals, and they will be forwarded as soon as possible.
