Summary of Information:

At approximately 0750 hours, 25 January 1993, the Office of Security Duty Office (OSDO) was notified by [redacted] that gunshots had been fired in the vicinity of the Route 123 Entrance. Security Duty Officer (SDO) [redacted] responded to the [redacted] and was notified that at least two persons were injured. SDO [redacted] notified SDO [redacted] who called Fairfax County Emergency Services and requested multiple ambulances. SDO [redacted] Lt. [redacted] and Lt. [redacted] SPS, immediately responded to the Visitor Control Center (VCC). (C)

SDO [redacted] arrived at the Visitor Control Center (VCC) at approximately 0800 hours, where she found SPO [redacted] administering first aid to [redacted] (SUBJECT#4) and SPO [redacted] and SPO [redacted] administering first aid to Nicholas Starr (SUBJECT#3). SPO [redacted] informed SDO [redacted] that both SUBJECTS had been shot while waiting at the light on Route 123 and that there were more wounded on Route 123. SPO [redacted] also advised SDO [redacted] that SPO [redacted] SPS Mobile Patrol, had responded to the scene on Route 123 and was assisting with the wounded.

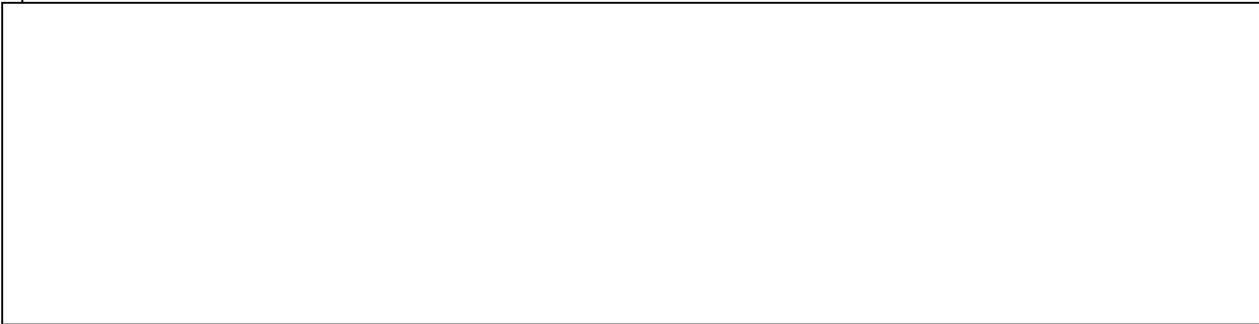
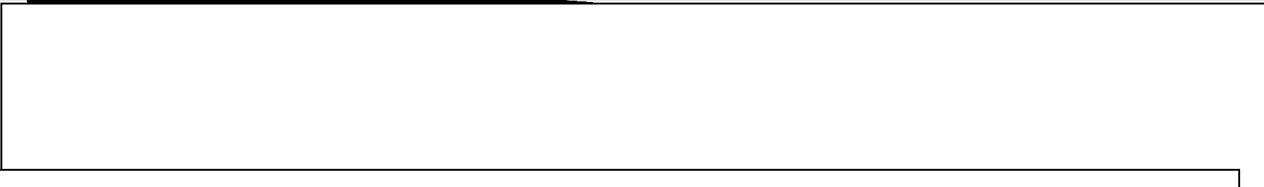
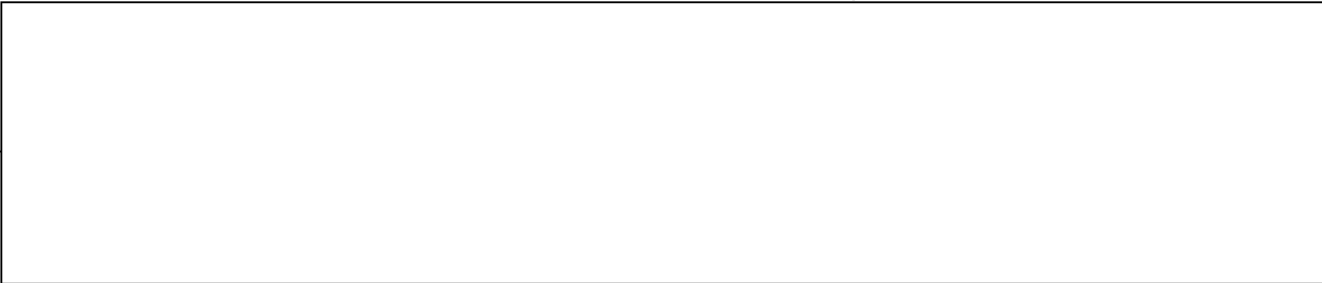
At approximately 0805 hours, Nurse [redacted] Nurse [redacted] and Dr. [redacted] as well as Physicians Assistants [redacted] and [redacted] arrived at the VCC and began assisting with the wounded. SDO [redacted] then began treating Judith Becker-Darling (SUBJECT#6) for shock. Judith Becker-Darling (SUBJECT#6) had been assisted to the VCC by [redacted] and [redacted] A Fairfax Fire and Rescue unit responded to the VCC and [redacted] Nicholas Starr (SUBJECT#3), who was subsequently transported to Route 123 where he was taken by helicopter to Fairfax Hospital. A second ambulance arrived and the EMTs treated [redacted] (SUBJECT#4), who was then transported to Arlington Hospital. [redacted] (SUBJECT#5) was transported by ambulance to Fairfax Hospital for [redacted]. (C)

At approximately 0825 hours, SPS personnel assisted Fairfax County Police in gathering witnesses in the VCC. At approximately 0830 hours, after establishing a crime scene on Route 123, Fairfax Detectives Gural and Detective Portee, Fairfax County Police, began interviewing the witnesses. The bodies of Frank Darling (SUBJECT#1) and Lansing Bennett (SUBJECT#2), killed in the incident, were left in their vehicles until their bodies were taken from the scene. The crime scene was maintained until approximately 1400 hours.



EVENT SUMMARY:

It was later determined that at approximately 0750 hours, on 25 January 1993, an individual, believed to be armed with an assault rifle, fired upon a line of vehicles waiting to proceed onto the Agency compound from Route 123. The vehicles were in the left hand turn lane, heading north on Route 123, and stopped at the red light. The gunman fired into several vehicles killing Frank Darling (SUBJECT#1) and Lansing Bennett (SUBJECT#2). Nicholas Starr (SUBJECT#3), [redacted] (SUBJECT#4), and [redacted] (SUBJECT#5), also received gunshot wounds. Judith Becker-Darling (SUBJECT#6), suffering from shock, was also medevaced as a result of witnessing the shootings. The gunman, described as a white male, average height and build, with dark hair, then fled the area in a vehicle described as a light brown van or station wagon. At this time he remains at large.
