Peru: Army Steps Up Antidrug Effort

After long claiming it had to focus almost exclusively on Sendero Luminoso insurgents, the Peruvian Army has become significantly more engaged in anti-drug missions.

Senior commanders almost certainly hope that the Army's antidrug successes in the southeast will help refurbish its image, which has been battered by highly publicized charges of human rights abuses [Redacted] Army commander General Hermoza personally touted the Army's recent drug seizures and arrests, according to press reports.
