1. I have had a message from 4359, through 7416 (which, incidentally, seems a rather peculiar way to communicate with me) relating to the pension paid to 4301's widow. You will remember that it was agreed that she should receive 500 kroner a month until the end of the war, and that arrangements were made in Copenhagen that 4355 should attend to this. 4359's question was whether I wanted this pension to be continued, and if so, would I give the necessary authority?
2. This seems to me to be rather out of order, since of course it is you who should decide, and you who give the necessary authority. As far as I am aware nothing has happened to make it desirable to stop the payment of the pension.
3. Would you please take whatever action you think desirable.
