As I advised you by telegram today, MULE is now back and he tells us that a contact has been arranged which means that CLUBS will sail from this port tomorrow evening. The rendezvous is KOBBERCHUNDEN and I hope that this time we shall be successful in transferring our stores.

None of the boys here can understand why BRAN's boat was at KOBBERGRUNDEN on August 8th. In accordance with a letter which BRAN had written to BEAVER, the boat (CLUBS) proceeded to a new rendezvous, namely, LASØ TRIBDEL. It is therefore not surprising that the boats did not spot each other. This hitch is still more difficult to understand in view of the fact that that we got our direct N/T message through to BRAN emphasing that it would be the new rendezvous this time, which was in accordance with his own suggestion.

I wonder whether you could provide me with a silhouette book for use by the crew of CLUBS to help them identify interesting craft which they may observe out at sea. This would help them in giving greater accuracy to any reports which might be of value to the 4. A.
