This is in response to your letter of 23 August 2000 to the Director of Central Intelligence (DCI), forwarding correspondence from your constituent, [redacted] contacted your office for assistance with respect to his concerns about "profiling" at the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), in connection with a January 2000 "60 Minutes" television program. He also wishes to submit a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the CIA in this regard.
