Inconsistent Stories on Accidental Deaths of French Scientists:



Comment: Major inconsistencies in our information on this incident are still unresolved. The original Reuters release gave the impression that the accidental poisoning had occurred within hours, but according to a newspaper article which announced the death of the third scientist, the men were stricken some 22 days before the Reuters announcement. Secondly, although the one scientist said he believed the accident occurred in a Pechiney-Saint Gobain plant at Salindres, a subsequent check does not show a Pechiney-Saint Gobain plant in Salindres.
