1. "Julio" is the Ecuadorian desk officer in the Seccion Sur (South American Section) of the Departamento de Liberacion Nacional (National Liberation Department - LN) in the Direccion General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGI).

2. "Julio" was born about 1940. He is about five feet eight inches tall, weighs between 155 and 160 pounds, and has a strong build. "Julio" is Caucasian, has a light complexion, blond hair, and green eyes. He resides on L Street, between 23rd and 25th Streets, Vedado, Habana, Cuba (in front of the Habana Hilton Hotel).
