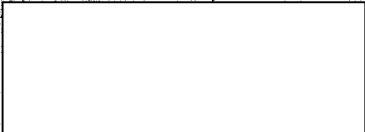

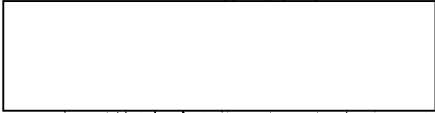

On 30 April 1955 said that President Ricardo ARIAS' mother had told the Condesa de KABAGO, the wife of the Spanish Ambassador to Panama, that Harmodio ARIAS, Sr. had visited her son "Dicky" ARIAS while Jose Ramon GUIZADO was President and had said that the latter would have to go because of his interference with ARIAS' business. Mrs. ARIAS also said that Harmodio ARIAS had visited his nephew, Ruben MIRO, at the Carcel Modelo at that time. Because of these events considers that Roberto ARIAS and his father, Harmodio ARIAS, are the prime suspects for having framed his father.

2. also said that when the Primer Forum del Pueblo Panamenol is held at the University of Panama in the near future a pamphlet will be distributed setting forth the story of Eduardo A. GRAU, regarding activities preceding the assassination of President Jose Antonio REMON, and charging Col. Bolivar VALLARINO with failure to take appropriate action.<sup>2</sup>
