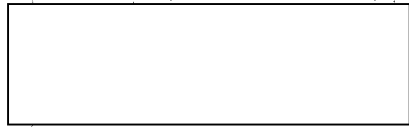

The assassination of President REMON of Panama caused no particular public reaction in Honduras, and none is expected since there are no close political ties between the two countries.

Comment. The Honduran Government has, however, declared a three-day mourning period and expressed condolences to the Panamanian Ambassador in Tegucigalpa.
