been raised before--most notably to Congress during the late 1980s--but the Working Group discovered no specific evidence of such an operation nor did the respondent provide any specific details to support his assertion. DI respondents provided little new, but one analyst wrote that he and other analysts felt that reporting on human rights abuses was inadequate and that collectors were not digging as deeply as they might have. What Gaps Remain? Serious gaps remain relative to the question of human rights abuses. In particular: why did they discover nothing about alleged human rights abuses--either to prove or disprove them? How could have followed up on ELACH-pursuing additional leads--if no one other than a few people report knowing of its existence? If asked information on ELACH, why can they remember nothing about it? The ELACH reports were deemed sufficiently important to notify to Congress about, but officers can provide no additional information about what they did to pursue leads on ELACH? Why do they not remember? ☐ How can it be common knowledge that the 316th Battalion committed abuses in the 1980s, but none of the respondents, had memories or specifics?
