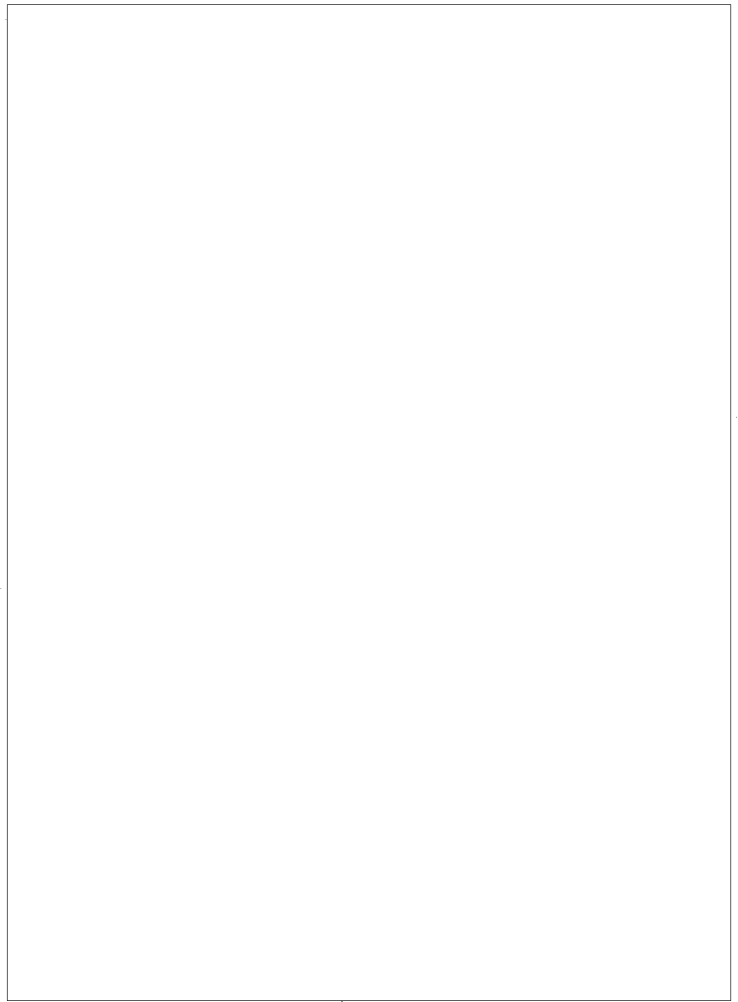

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Mr. John Caranci, [redacted]

1. Dr. [redacted] was unable to reach Mr. Caranci's new doctor at Boston yesterday but did reach him this afternoon. The doctor reports that Mr. Caranci will have to remain at the Leahy Clinic for at least two more weeks during which time he will undergo additional treatment. The doctor reported Mr. Caranci is not feeling too well at this point. Dr. [redacted] will call again about 10 April to learn the progress made during the coming ten days.

2. Dr. [redacted] has spoken with Mr. [redacted] of [redacted] and Mr. [redacted] indicated that it might be well at this point for someone from [redacted] to go to Boston and attempt to have Mr. Caranci apply for disability retirement. If he were to do so he would at least get back on a payroll as soon as the application is approved, since as earlier reported Mr. Caranci ran out of all accrued and advanced leave beginning 23 March 1970.
