

MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: BX6734 (Incident Concerning)

- 1. Subject mission was flown successfully on 30 October 1967. An examination of the mission vehicle upon its return to the Kadena Detachment revealed the presence of a single hole, approximately the size which would have been made by a 30.06 shell. This hole was located in a fillet just aft of the starboard landing gear. The pellet which caused the hole penetrated the outer skin, a metallic support which is utilized to stiffen same and also another metallic support for one of the fuel tanks.
- 2. Attached are two photographs of the aforementioned holes. Exhibit A is a view of the skin fillet from the inner side. Exhibit B is a view of the tank support from the outer side.
- 3. The aforementioned pellet was previously returned by courier for analysis.
