WESTERN HEMISPHERE

Chile

A west coast listening post intercepted a message from CEA2. Santiago, Chile, sent by the Mexican Ambassador, Santiago, to the foreign office, Mexico City, telling of a great demonstration by labor unions in Chile expressing their solidarity with Mexico. Full text of the message is going to the American Branch. A comment might be made that this is a powerful wedge by which Chile can be pried from its present position.

BRITISH EMPIRE

South Africa

The following message was transmitted by Station XBB, Mexico, 16075 KC at 0114 to Station FYX, Lyons, France, addressed to Beydemun, Box 5102, Johannesburg. It says "Congratulations withing I happiness with bridge". Signed Yahoa.

Station XBB used to be Triangulos Island. Mexico, but the call letters have appeared on no active list during the past four years. It should, therefore, be definitely a suspect and if the Johannesburg address is genuine, this communication via France might be of great interest.
