SUBJECT: Meeting on United States War Crimes (NL)

1. [redacted] reported that the Comité pour la Dénonciation de Crimes de Guerre is sponsoring a six-hour meeting on United States war crimes in Vietnam on 13 May 1971 in Paris. The meeting will utilize tape recordings made by Mark LANE, tape recordings by American soldiers giving testimony on atrocities, and tape recordings on brainwashing of prisoners during interrogation. Although the sponsors wanted Americans to participate in the program, no funds were available to bring them from the United States. Americans living in Paris who were solicited to participate have thus far refused.

2. The Comité pour la Dénonciation de Crimes de Guerre is the successor to the Bertrand Russell War Crimes Tribunal in Paris.
