It is not known whether [redacted] plans materialized in this respect and the mission was reportedly ultimately abandoned as too risky.

3. Additionally, other SLA members allegedly gained entry to the office of [redacted] during the same approximate time period and for the same purpose. According to the [redacted] information, [redacted] is a close associate of Wendy Yoshimura and is presently free on bail following an arrest for the [redacted] bank robbery carried out by the SLA in the spring of 1975. A bank patron was killed during that robbery. Yoshimura was captured with Patty Hearst and Emily and William Harris in San Francisco in September of 1975. The [redacted] sources state that little is known about [redacted], although she is believed to be one of a number of SLA members whose identities had not surfaced until quite recently, following the arrests in San Francisco last year. [redacted] may have been active in a number of assaults by the SLA and its umbrella organization, The New World Liberation Front (NWLFF), during 1974-75. The current whereabouts of [redacted] are unknown.

4. As stated previously, [redacted] is desirous of discussing this information with representatives of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Since this matter is not within the purview of this Agency, this information is being furnished to your Bureau for whatever action you may deem appropriate.
