Under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. subsection 552, I am requesting information or records on Kemal Aygün, a Turkish bureaucrat who was assigned to multiple positions during the rule of the Democrat Party between 1950 and 1960. Among many of his assignments, he was head of the General Security Administration and head of the Istanbul regional administration (*İstanbul Belediye Reisi*). He was also put on trial with President Celal Bayar and Prime Minister Adnan Menderes in after the May 1960 coup.

If there are any fees for searching for, reviewing, or copying the records, please let me know before you task my request. I am engaged in this research as a part of a broader academic study of Turkey during the 1950s.

If you deny all or any part of this request, please cite each specific exemption you think justifies your refusal to release the information and notify me of appeal procedures available under the law.
