Dear FOIA director, U.S. Central Intelligence Agency:

Please send me your finished intelligence generated since Jan. 1, 2008, on your estimates of Canada's entire and recoverable oil reserves for the foreseeable future, its environmental, carbon, and climate change impacts, and its relationship to the United States' energy needs, foreign affairs and security, and the Canadian oil (especially Albertan) impact on global economy and politics.

Please do not send records that have been released elsewhere, e.g. the CIA Yearly Factbook (although if you know of such sources on this topic, please direct me to where I can find those). If any of these records are in readable computer format, please send them by disc or email rather than on paper.

Please exempt me from fees as I am a low budget news reporter working for the public and educational interest. I am willing to pay fees up to \$25.

If you wish to negotiate this request, please call or write me. (FYI, notes on my work can be found at my FOI page)

On January 21, 2009, President Barack Obama issued an Executive Order: "The Government should not keep information confidential merely because public officials might be embarrassed by disclosure, because errors and failures might be revealed, or because of speculative or abstract fears. All agencies should adopt a presumption in favor of disclosure, in order to renew their commitment to the principles embodied in FOIA, and to usher in a new era of open Government." Please reply in this spirit.
