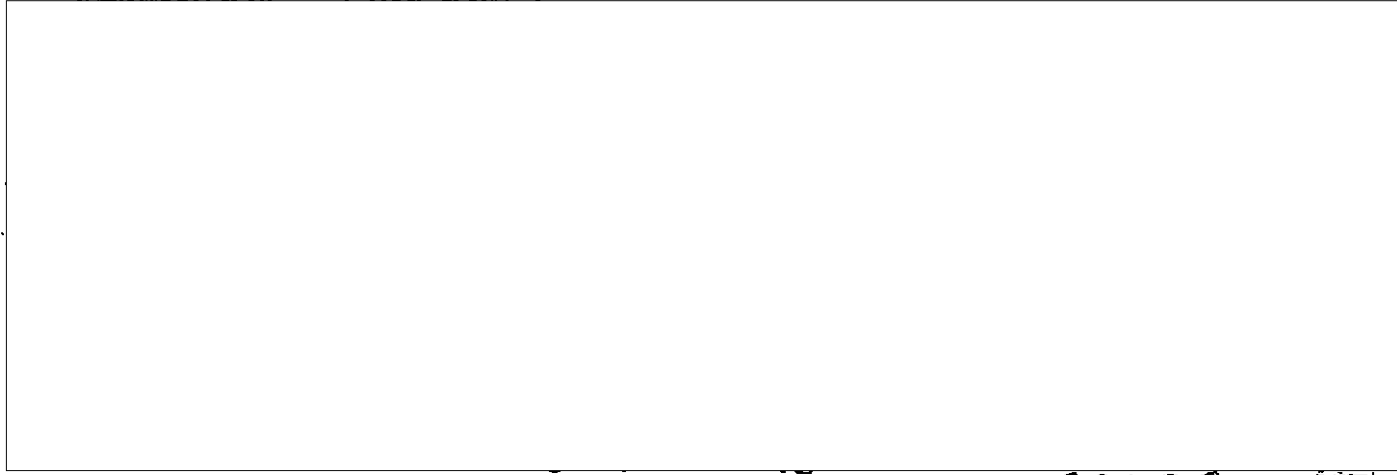

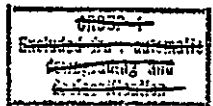
Your Bureau has previously furnished this Agency an investigative report, dated 31 October 1956, Newark, New Jersey, which contains the results of an interview of Zworykin by your Bureau in October 1956. It is noted that during this interview, Zworykin stated that he had been contacted by a Russian official "a little less than a year ago," when one "Koch" (phonetic), who represented himself as a Soviet United Nations staff member from New York City, delivered a letter to Zworykin from his sister who was a physician in Moscow.

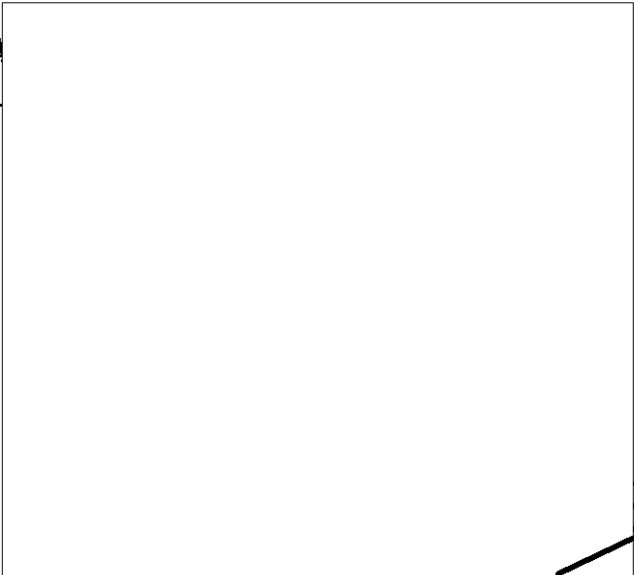
