SUBJECT: Carlton Benjamin GOODLETT; Attendance at the Afro-Asian People's Solidarity Organization Conference

in Conakry, Guinea (NL)

1. The 19 November 1971 issue of the official Guinean government newspaper "Horoya" reported the arrival of Carlton GOODLETT as the American delegate to an Afro-Asian Peoples Solidarity Organization conference being held in Conakry, Guinea, 20-22 November 1971. It was noted that GOODLETT arrived in Guinea on 17 November via Air Guinea from Bamako, Mali, in the company of the following other delegates: Mahmoud TOBBO of Lebanon; MalaviyaXHARSMEO of India; Borgary SAKO of Mali, Vladimir IORDANSKY of the Soviet Union; and Joao Burza BELLINE of Brazil.

2. GOODLETT was quoted as thanking the Guinean people for the hospitality they have shown to NKRUMAH and also on several "aspects" of the battle "his organization" is carrying on inside the United States against Gulf Oil Company in Angola and American banks in South Africa.
