1. In response to your request for information concerning Carlton GOODLETT's activities at the World Peace Council (WCP) meeting in New Delhi we have received the following information

A. GOODLETT, Sidney PECK (Bureau File 100-26799), and James FOREST (Bureau File 100-21326) were the only Americans attending the WCP meeting in New Delhi. PECK was described as young, dynamic, and more militant than GOODLETT, who was termed a complete "organization man." PECK, who attended as an invitee, had not yet been accepted into the inner circles of the WCP, although he was apparently being scrutinized by the leadership. PECK spoke of the necessity of integrating the "working class" and the blacks into the peace movement. Both he and GOODLETT appealed to the WCP for increased support of the American peace movement on the part of international peace organizations.

C. PECK was subsequently reported as transiting Vientiane, Laos enroute to Hanoi, North Vietnam aboard an Aeroflot flight on 23 October 1970. (Comment: According to Department of State Telegram, Vientiane 07192, dated 30 October 1970, a copy of which was sent to your Bureau, PECK was to pass through Vientiane again on his return trip from Hanoi on 30 October. However, PECK was not on any of the flights from Hanoi on that day.)

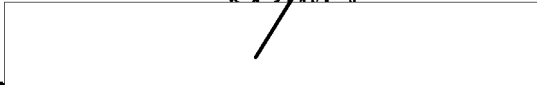
