Irving SARNOFF participated in a round-table televised discussion on the evening of 13 December 1969. One of the other participants in this discussion was Cheddi JAGAN, from Guyana. SARNOFF made only two comments: The majority of the American public is now in sympathy with the peace movement, and the main problem is to force this peace issue on the United States Government; the next phase of the peace offensive would be the politicizing of the United States Armed Forces.
