SUBJECT: Carlton GOODLETT

1. [Redacted] has reported that Subject is called "Carlos" by his friends. He is an active and influential member of the San Francisco community since he publishes a newspaper, is a medical doctor and has large real-estate holdings. He is associated with two other black men in one real-estate deal involving the ownership and maintenance of the large building which houses the public parking facility at the San Francisco International Airport.

2. However, in spite of all of his business and professional commitments he is able to remain most active in the area of radical politics. He has traveled widely throughout the world, attended many meetings and conferences of radicals and is known to many leaders of the World Council of Peace in Helsinki, including Romesh CHANDRA. It was probably CHANDRA who invited Subject to attend the World Council of Peace meeting which was held in Khartoum, Sudan, on 15 December 1969. Although Subject is wealthy enough to have paid his own way to Khartoum, it is believed that the World Council of Peace defrayed all expenses. Subject did attend the meeting in Khartoum and is presently working again in San Francisco. He traveled to Khartoum with Irving SARNOFF of Los Angeles.

3. Subject is frequently noted eating luncheon in San Francisco with Eleanor JOHMAN, his personal secretary, and with Thomas FLEMING, a writer for the San Francisco Sun Reporter, Subject's newspaper.

4. Subject is expressing an unusual amount of interest in the occupation of Alcatraz by the American Indians. He has made contacts with some of the Indian leaders in order to discuss mutual aims and interests. Subject has even entertained some Indians in his home for dinner.
