I have discussed with Duncan Lee your letter to me of March 24, 1943, about American Service Corporation.

As we recall it, setting up this Corporation was a nonprofit matter as far as Sperry was concerned, and as you know the enterprise ultimately fell through. From their point of view I think it must be regarded as in the nature of a public service and I regarded in the same light the Colonel's request that we help them set the company up.

I am afraid this is about the only help I can give you on the matter. The question of billing Sperry is pretty much a matter of firm policy and will depend a good deal, I imagine, on the overall picture with reference to them.
