
Dear Paul,

Thank you for your letter of 22 May 1945. I don't think there is anything more to say on this subject until I get out. Except, possibly this. First, although I am greatly flattered by your estimate of what I am doing here in Washington, I feel sure that at least as good work can be done by several men who are hereabouts and would be available. Secondly, I have not proposed coming out with any romantic ideas either about the pleasure of living in the Theater or about the duration of the assignment. I do think I realise that it is an extremely rugged theater and cortainly realise that any assignment would be for 13 months or more.
