THE EX-GI'S PLAN TO ACTIVE-LY RECRUIT MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DEMONSTRATIONS AND WILL TRAVEL TO FORT MEADE, MARYLAND, IN THE NEAR FUTURE TO ENCOURAGE ACTIVE DUTY GI'S TO ATTEND THE DEMONSTRATIONS IN WASHINGTON (X)

SOURCE FURTHER RELATED THAT THE PREVAILING OPINION AMONG LEADERS OF THE DEMONSTRATION IS THAT IT WILL BE PEACEFUL AND NON-VIOLENT. THE LEADERS ALSO BELIEVE THAT DESPITE THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT'S NEGATIVE DECISION, IT REALLY HAS NO CHOICE IN THE END BUT TO LET THE DEMONSTRATORS USE ROCK CREEK PARK AS A CAMPING GROUNDS. THE LEADERS FURTHER BELIEVE THAT IF THE GOVERNMENT DECIDES TO CALL OUT TROOPS OR GAS THE DEMONSTRATORS OUT OF THE PARK, IT MAY PROVOKE THE DEMONSTRATORS TO A VIOLENT COURSE OF ACTION A GP-1
