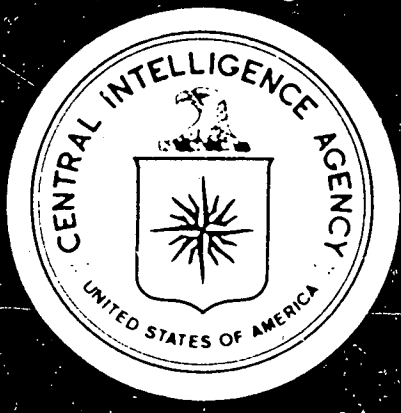

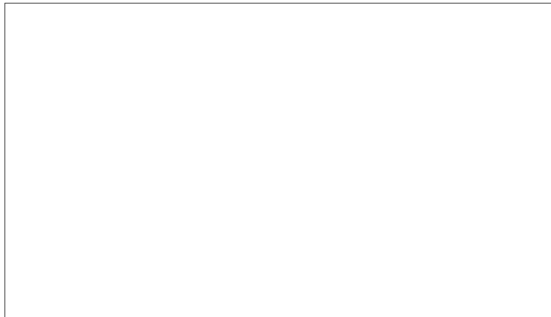
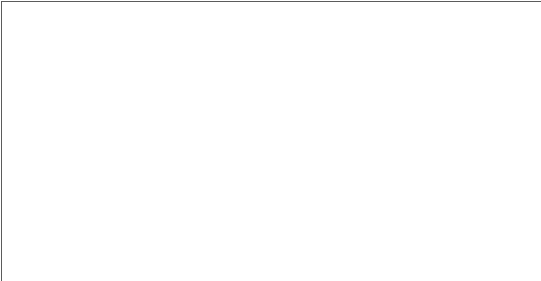
USSR: Mobile Missile System



The Soviets are moving ahead with plans to field a mobile missile system, probably the SS-X-20 intermediate-range ballistic missile [redacted]

[redacted] The first SS-X-20 unit may be operational by the end of this year or early next year.

[redacted] the Soviets are continuing to construct new buildings at two SS-4 sites in the western USSR and at a partially dismantled SS-7 ICBM site in the eastern USSR. These facilities are probably being constructed to be used as support bases for the SS-X-20.



The developmental flight test program for the SS-X-20 apparently is complete. This two-stage, solid-propellant missile has a demonstrated range of 2,200 nautical miles and has three warheads, [redacted]

[redacted] The SS-X-20 is significantly more accurate than the SS-4 MRBM and SS-5 IRBM it is replacing.
