

2. Laos

a. Yesterday Vientiane was alive with conflicting reports of coup and counter-coup plotting among the rightists, with Kouprasith and the Sananikone faimly on one side and Phoumi on the other.

b. Security chief General Siho indicated last night to Ambassador Unger that he was attempting to iron out the situation. This means Siho is trying to keep a foot in both camps.

c. There have been some indications of stepped-up Pathet Lao military pressures in several widely separated areas.

3. Cyprus

- a. Makarios now says that no agreement reached in Geneva could be binding without his personal approval and that the Greek Government cannot speak for Cyprus.
- b. A Greek Army officer has told Ambassador Belcher that Greek troops are on Cyprus not only to defend the island, but as "insurance" against Makarios "getting out of hand."
