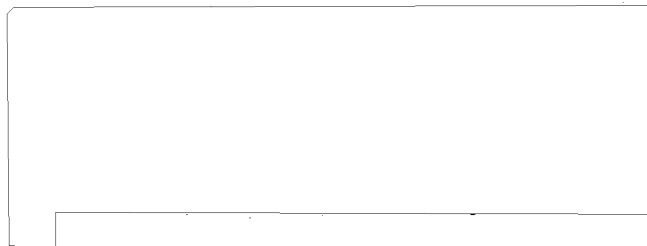
SOUTH VIETNAM - CAMBODIA

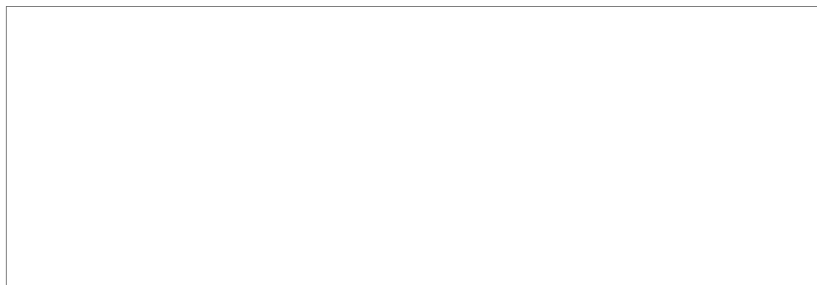

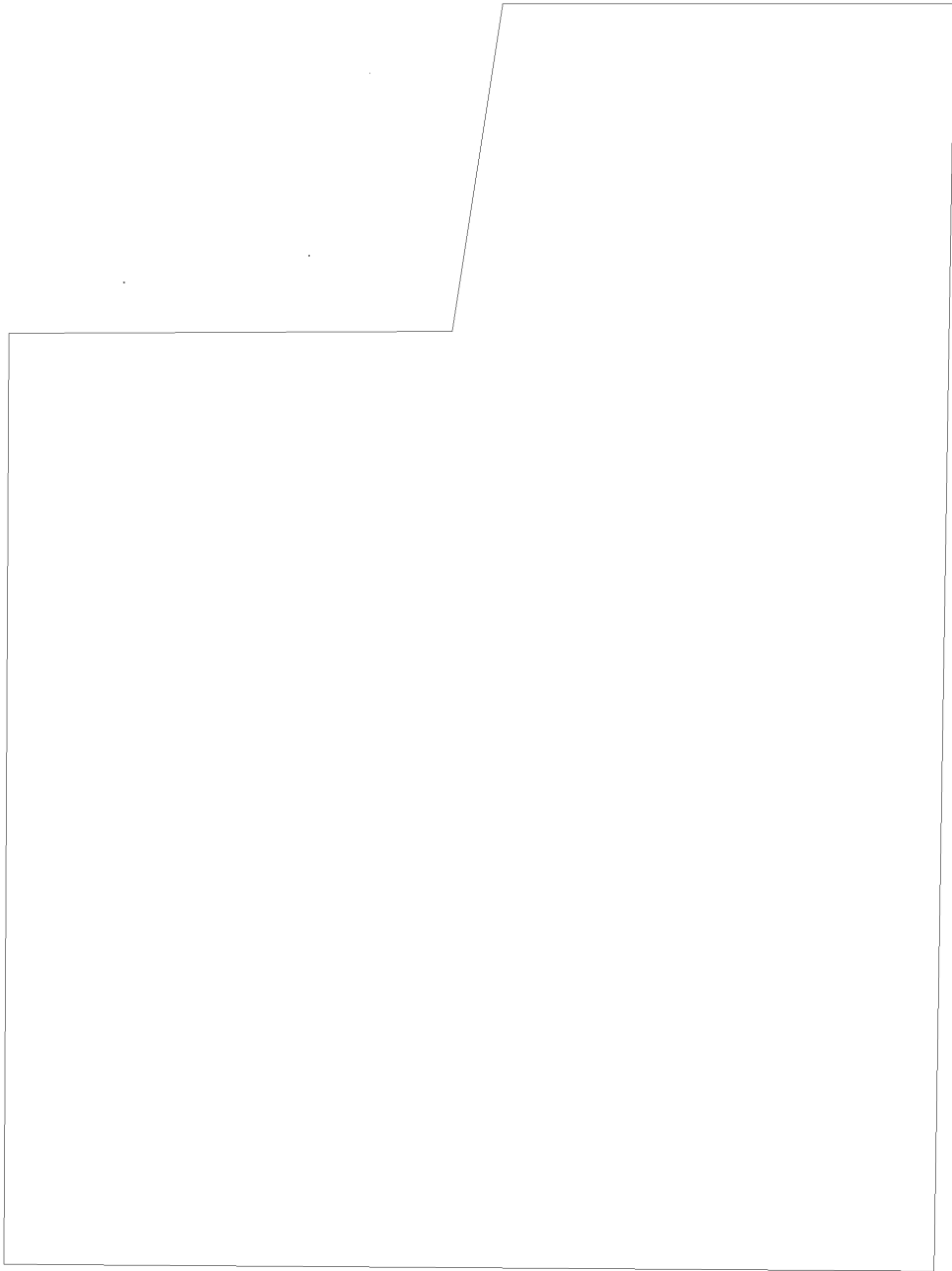

USSR: [redacted] a deputy chairman of the State Planning Commission (Gosplan) said that last April the Commission was directed to rework the draft of the next five-year plan (1971-75) in order to reflect a Politburo decision to devote more resources to agriculture. The decision was causing major problems, in part because the share of investments available for various otherwise unidentified "large new industrial projects" had to be reduced. [redacted]
