## l. Algeria

Algerian leaders have papered over their quarrel with an agreement which enables Ben Bella and his politburo to govern the country while Ben Khedda and the Provisional government "supervise matters of state"-i.e., foreign affairs. This arrangement is supposed to survive until elections for a national assembly are held in "about a month." The round thus goes to Ben Bella, but his adversaries are bitter and unreconciled, and the coming month will see some of the roughest sort of political in-50X1 fighting (Arab style).
