- A. THE CEASE-FIRE SEEMS TO BE HOLDING SO FAR.
- B. NEW DELHI STANDS NONCOMMITTAL ON THE CHINESE PROPOSAL
 ON WITHDRAWAL AND NEGOTIATIONS. IT WILL PROBABLY
 REMAIN SO FOR AN OTHER DAY OR TWO UNTIL IT FEELS IT BETTER UNDERSTANDS
 THE, IMPLICATIONS OF THE PROPOSAL AND UNTIL THE SEPARATE STRANDS
 OF THENKING WITHIN THE GOVERNMENT MEET IN SOME KIND OF CONSENSUS.
 ALT HOUGH NEHRU APPEARS TO BE SOMEWHAT LESS SKEPTICAL OF CHINESE
 INTENTIONS THAN SOME OF HIS AIDES, HE KNOWS HE IS WALING ON EGGS.
 JUST BEFORE THE CHINESE PROPOSAL WAS MADE, HE TOLD SENATOR MANSFIELD THAT APART FROM HIS OWN CONVICTIONS HE COULD NOT STAY IN
 OFFICE A WEEK IF HE NEGOTIATED WITH THE CHINESE NOW.

- B. PRIVATELY, HOWEVER, FOREIGN MINISTER MOHAMMAD ALI HAS TOLD OUR AMBASSADOR THAT HIS GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO HOLD BASICALLY TO ITS PRESENT FOREIGN POLICY ORIENTATION, INCLUDING MEMBERSHIP IN BOTH CENTO AND SEATO. HE SAID THAT AYUB WOULD SO INFORM A CLOSED SESSION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY. HE HIM-SELF WOULD SPEAK IN OPEN SESSION AND WOULD "HAVE TO DO SOME JUGGLING."
- C. HE WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE PAKISTANI GOVERNMENT HAS NO ILLUSIONS ABOUT CHINESE RUTHLESSNESS, THAT THERE COULD BE NO REAL FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN THEM, "SINCE OIL AND WATER DO NOT MIS,"
 BUT THAT PAKISTAN CANNOT AFFORD TO RUB THE CHINESE THE WRONG WAY NOW.
- D. IT IS ALSO EVIDENT THAT PAKISTAN AIMS TO KEEP THE PRESSURE ON THE INDIANS FOR NEGOTIATIONS ON KASHMIR. THEY SEE A BORDER AGREEMENT WITH THE CHINESE, ON WHICH DISCUSSIONS ARE IN PROGRESS, AS A PART OF THIS SCHEME.
- A. ORDERS TO CUBAN MILITARY UNITS TO FIRE ON "ENEMY" AIRCRAFT WERE CANCELLED YESTERDAY "UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE." THE BAN ON CIVIL FLIGHTS OVER CUBA WAS LIFTED AN HOUR LATER.
- B. SUBSEQUENT INFORMATION MAKES IT APPARENT THAT THE TWO
 JETS FIRED ON BY CUBAN ANTIAIRCRAFT UNITS LAST MONDAY WERE NOT
 CURS. THE JUMPY CUBANS MUST HAVE BEEN FIRING AT THEIR OWN OR
 SO WET PLANES.

C. WITHIN A MATTER OF HOURS AFTER A PRESS REPORT ON WEDNESDAY
THAT MIKO YAM HAD SIGNED A NEW ECONOMIC AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CUBANS,
HAVANA WAS OUT WITH A STATEMENT SAYING THE STORY WAS "COMPLETELY
FALSE" AND THAT "IN THE COURSE OF THE TALKS CARRIED OUT DURING THE
DEVELOPMENT OF THE PRESENT CRISIS, CUBA HAS NOT SIGNED ANY AGREEMENT
WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SOVIET UNION." THIS SOUNDS AS THOUGH
THE CUBANS DONOT LIKE THE IMPLICATION THAT THEY HAVE BEEN BOUGHT
OFF BYMIKOYAN.

D. YESTERDAY 'S HIGH-LEVEL PHOTOGRAPHIC MISSION REVEALED NO CHANGE IN THE STATUS OF THE NINE IL-28 CRATES STANDING AT THE HOLGUIN AIRFIELD. ONE HIGH-LEVEL MISSION WAS FLOWN ON WEDNESDAY OVER ORIENTE PROVINCE WITH NO SIGNIFICANT RESULTS.

- A. TENSION IS RUNNING HIGH WITHIN THE SEVEN-MAN COUNCIL OF STATE ONLY A MONTH BEFORE THE SCHEDULED ELECTION OF A DOMINICAN PRESIDENT AND CONGRESS. THE DOMINICAN FOREIGN MINISTER DESCRIBES THE SITUATION AS "EXPLOSIVE."
- B. THE SOURCE OF TENSION IS THE GRASPING AMBITIONS OF TWO OF THE COUNCIL MEMBERS, IMBERT AND AMIAMA. THESE TWO, THE ONLY SURVIVORS OF THE TEAM WHICH ASSASSINATED TRUJILLO, HAVE ALREADY ESTABLISHED INFLHENCE OVER THE POLICE AND ARE REACHING FOR THE ARMY. PRESIDENT BOWNELLY IS BEING URGED TO CURB THEM BUT FEARS THAT IF HE DOES HE WILL ENDANGER THE ELECTIONS SCHEDULED FOR 20 DECEMBER AND POSSIBLY HIS OWN SAFETY.
- C. AMBASSADOR MARTIN SAYS OF AMIAMA AND IMBERT: "WE HAVE
 HEARD THEY STEAL AND WE KNOW THEY LIE, BUT OUR MOST SERIOUS COMPLAINT
 ABOUT THEM IS OUR OPINION OF THEIR FUTURE INTENTIONS--TO NULLIFY
 REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY."
- A. MOSCOW SEEMS TO BE READYING A "COMPROMISE" PROPOSAL AND A NUCLEAR TEST BAN TO LAY BEFORE THE DISARMAMENT CONFERENCE WHEN IT REOPENS IN GENEVA ON MONDAY. HINTS HAVE COME FROM SOVIET DIP-LO MATS AND THE SOVIET PRESS THAT THE PROPOSAL WILL CALL FOR A MORATORIUM OF FIXED AND LIMITED DURATION ON UNDERGOUND GESTS WHILE TREATY NEGOTIATIONS CONTINUE.
