

## THE PRESIDENT'S INTELLIGENCE CHECKLIST--15 DECEMBER 1962

## 1. NORTH KOREA - USSR:

A. THE SOVIETS HAVE BEEN TRYING TO WOO THE NORTH KOREANS AWAY FROM THE CHINESE BY A NUMBER OF DEVICES. EVEN THOUGH THE NORTH KOREANS AT THE CZECH PARTY CONGRESS SUPPORTED THE CHINESE THERE (AT LEAST PASSIVELY), WE SUSPECT THE KOREAN DELEGATION, WHICH WAS IN MOSCOW LATE IN NOVEMBER, STRUCK SOME SORT OF BARGAIN.

## 2. SINO-SOVIET DISPUTE:

- A. PEIPING HAS RESPONDED TO KHRUSHCHEV BY PUBLISHING A STATEMENT IT SUBMITTED TO A CLOSED SESSION OF THE CZECH PARTY CONGRESS LAST WEEK.
- B. THE STATEMENT PROTESTED ATTACKS BY CONGRESS PARTICIPANTS ON THE CHINESE AND ALBANIAN PARTIES AND WARNED THAT THEIR

CONTINUATION COULD LEAD TO A SINO-SOVIET "SPLIT." THE CHINESE BLAMED THE SOVIETS FOR THE PRESENT DISARRAY IN THE BLOC AND THE "EVEN MORE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES WHICH MAY FOLLOW."

THEY ASKED FOR ANOTHER CONFERENCE OF COMMUNIST PARTIES SUCH AS WAS HELD IN 1957 AND 1960 TO COMPOSE DIFFERENCES.

- C. MOSCOW, WE ARE SURE, WOULD OPPOSE THIS. THERE IS NO REASON TO THINK CHINA WOULD BE ANY MORE WILLING THEN THAN NOW TO SUBMIT TO THE VIEWS OF THE MAJORTIY.
- D. THE SOVIETS AND EAST EUROPEANS WILL, HOWEVER, PROBABLY FEEL CALLED UPON TO REPLY EVEN MORE EXPLICITLY.
- A. WE DO NOT YET KNOW THE REACTION IN LEOPOLDVILLE TO TSHOMBE'S INDICATED WILLINGNESS TO HAVE UNION MINIERE'S FOR-

EIGN EXCHANGE PAID TO THE UN MONETARY COUNCIL.

3. CONGO:

- C. THE 5,700-MAN INDIAN BRIGADE IS DUE TO GO HOME IN FEBRUARY, AND INDIA HAS NOTIFIED THE UN THAT IT WILL NOT BE REPLACED. THE FORCE MAKES UP ABOUT HALF THE UN CONTINGENT IN KATANGA AND ABOUT ONE THIRD OF THE ENTIRE UN CONGO FORCE.
- D. THE ONLY NEW FORCE SCHEDULED TO ARRIVE IN THE CONGO (1,800 INDONESIANS) WILL BEGIN ARRIVING IN KATANGA EARLY NEXT WEEK.
