D. INDONESIAN OFFICIALS ARE CONCERNED OVER THE UNEXPLAINED FAILURE OF A DELEGATION OF SOVIET ECONOMIC EXPERTS TO ARRIVE IN DJAKARTA, AS SCHEDULED, ON 15 DECEMBER. THE INDONESIANS HAVE BEEN ANXIOUSLY WAITING TO FIND OUT WHAT MOSCOW MIGHT ASK IN RETURN FOR KHRUSHCHEV'S AGREEMENT LAST MONTH TO PERMIT SOME STRETCHOUT IN THE DEBT REPAYMENT SCHEDULE.

4. INDIA-PAKISTAN:

- A. THE INDIAN HIGH COMMISSIONER IN LONDON HAS MADE WHAT
 WAS DESCRIBED AS A "STRONG DEMARCHE" TO THE BRITISH TO THE EFFECT
 THAT NEW DELHI WOULD OBJECT STRENUOUSLY IF CONTINUATION OF
 "GENEROUS" ARMS AID WERE MADE CONTINGENT ON SETTLEMENT OF INDIANPAKISTAN DIFFERENCES.
- C. THE SAME NOTE IS BEING SOUNDED BY INDIAN OFFICIALS AND THE PRESS IN NEW DELHI. NEHRU TOLD A US INTERVIEWER YESTERDAY

THAT THE INDIANS WOULD NOT GIVE IN TO THE CHINESE WHETHER THERE WAS WESTERN AID OR NOT, BUT SAID HE DOUBTED THAT US AID WOULD BE WITH-HELD IF THERE WERE NO KASHMIR SETTLEMENT.

- A. THE STRIKE-CONNECTED VIOLENCE AT THE US-OWNED MINING IN-STALLATION AT LA OROYA HAS HALTED, LEAVING BEHIND SCORES OF CASUALTIES AND PROPERTY DAMAGE IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD OF \$4 MILLION.

- C. THE MILITARY JUNTA BEGINS TO SEE THAT IT WENT WRONG IN ACCEPTING COMMUNIST SUPPORT ON THE SLY OUT OF AN URGE TO CRIPPLE THE LEFTIST, NON-COMMUNIST APRA PARTY. A CRACKDOWN ON THE COMMUNIST SEEMS TO BE IN THE MAKING.

THE 1962 AGRICULTURAL YEAR TO CONCLUDE THAT NET OUTPUT WAS THE LOWEST IN YEARS-LOWER IN FACT THAN IN ANY OF THE POST-WAR YEARS FOR WHICH WE HAVE REASONABLY GOOD FIGURES.

- B. HEAVY SETBACKS DUE TO NATURAL CAUSES IN SOME AREAS, PARTICULARLY THE NORTHERN PART OF EUROPEAN RUSSIA, COMBINED WITH THE PERENNIAL DEFECTS OF THE SYSTEM TO PRODUCE THE DISMAL OUTCOME.

 PARTY SPOKESMEN IN THE BALTIC REPUBLIC COMPARE THIS YEAR'S EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS TO THOSE OF THE FAMINE YEAR OF 1928.

D. MALAYSIA: THE GOVERNMENTS OF MALAYA AND SINGAPORE ARE CALLING ONE ANOTHER NAMES IN A DISPUTE, A BY-PRODUCT OF THE BRUNEI REVOLT, WHICH DEALS A FURTHER SETBACK TO THE PROJECTED MALAYSIAN FEDERATION. THE ISSUE, WHICH TURNS ON THE SCOPE IN THE TWO TERRITORIES OF THE SECURITY ROUNDUP GENERATED BY THE BRUNEI REBELLION, HAS MALAYAN PREMIER RAHMAN TALKING IN OVERCHARGED TONES OF GOING AHEAD WITH THE FEDERATION WITHOUT SINGAPORE.

- E. MEXICO: PRESIDENT LOPEZ MATEOS SAID YESTERDAY
 AT A BANGUET FOR PRESIDENT ALESSANDRI THAT MEXICO WOULD
 BE WILLING TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT ON THE DENUCLEARIZATION
 OF LATIN AMERICA IF AN "IMPORTANT GROUP" OF LATIN AMERICAN
 NATIONS ALSO SUBSCRIBED TO THE PRINCIPLE.
- F. CONGO: TSHOMBE, REPLYING TO A LETTER FORM U THANT ON MONDAY, YESTERDAY NOTIFIED THE UN THAT HE IS READY TO SEND A DELEGATION TO LEOPOLDVILLE TO NEGOTIATE ON THE PROPOSAL TO ROUTE UNION MINIERE REVENUES THROUGH THE MONETARY COUNCIL.
