3. Arab States

a. Iraq and Syria seem to be trying to relieve pressures for union with the UAR by paying lip service to the idea of Arab solidarity.

b. The Deputy Prime Minister of Iraq has called for a joint military and political command embracing the UAR, Iraq, Syria, Algeria and Yemen. The thought is clear that the UAR would be one among many, not the vanguard, even supposing that an arrangement of this kind can be given practical force.
