

THE PRESIDENT'S INTELLIGENCE CHECKLIST--29 JUNE 1963

## 1. USSR:

- A. KHRUSHCHEV'S RAMBLING 21 JUNE SPEECH TO THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE PLENUM, JUST PUBLISHED, LOOKS LIKE AN EFFORT TO STRENGTHEN DISCIPLINE WITHIN THE SOVIET PARTY BEFORE THE FORTH-COMING CONFRONTATION WITH THE CHINESE.
- B. LASHING OUT AT BOTH DEVIATIONISTS AND RECALCITRANT INTELLECTUALS HE WARNED THAT DEVIATION FROM THE KREMLIN LINE COULD GET ONE THROWN OUT OF THE PARTY.
- C. THE SPEECH GAVE NO NEW INSIGHTS ON MOSCOW'S TACTICS
  IN THE 5 JULY SINO-SOVIET MEETING OR ON SOVIET FOREIGN POLICY.
- D. KHRUSHCHEV WILL PROBABLY UTILIZE THE GATHERING TOMORROW OF EAST EUROPEAN PARTY CHIEFS IN EAST BERLIN--ALL BUT RUMANIA'S GHEORGHIU-DEJ--TO COORDINATE STRATEGY FOR NEXT WEEK'S MEETING.
- 2. USSR COMMUNIST CHINA:
- A. PEIPING HAS SCORED A POINT IN ITS BATTLE TO LINE UP SUPPORT IN SOVIET-LED FOREIGN COMMUNIST PARTIES.
- B. PRO-CHINESE "REBELS" HAVE SPLIT THE BELGIAN COMMUNIST PARTY, AND ARE NOW BIDDING FOR CONTROL. THEY MAY NOT MAKE IT, BUT THEIR SPLINTER GROUP WILL NEVERTHELESS BE A USEFUL TOOL FOR PEIPING.

## 3. BRITISH GUIANA:

A. THERE NOW APPEARS TO BE SOME PROSPECT OF SETTLING THE 71 DAY OLD STRIKE UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH WOULD LEAVE JAGAN'S GOVERNMENT SUBSTANTIALLY INTACT.

E. AT THE SAME TIME, NO PROGRESS IS BEING MADE IN BUD-DHIST-GOVERNMENT RELATIONS. THE TWO-WEEK TIME LIMIT THE BUD-DHISTS SET FOR THE GOVERNMENT TO DEMONSTRATE ITS INTENTION TO END RELIGIOUS DISCRIMINATION COMES TO AN END TOMORROW.

## 5. NOTES:

- A. BRAZIL: GOULART APPEARS TO HAVE BACKED OFF FROM TRYING TO ARRANGE A MEETING WITH PRESIDENT KENNEDY IN ROME. HIS
  SPOKESMAN TOLD THE PRESS HE DID NOT RULE OUT AN INFORMAL ENCOUNTER
  BUT THE "NORTH AMERICANS ARE NOT GIVEN TO DEALING ON SUBSTANTIVE
  MATTERS WITHOUT CAREFUL ADVANCE PREPARATIONS." ON THE SUBJECT
  OF VISITORS TO ROME, WE STILL HAVE NO INDICATION OF A DE GAULLE
  VISIT.
- B. IRAN: RELIGIOUS LEADERS AND OTHERS OPPOSED TO THE SHAH'S REFORM PROGRAM SEEM TO BE BREWING UP MORE DEMONSTRATIONS FOR MID-JULY. THE SECURITY FORCES, ALERT TO THIS POSSIBILITY, WILL PROBABLY RESPOND MORE QUICKLY THAN THEY DID EARLY THIS MONTH.
- C. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: THE GROUP WITHIN THE CZECH PARTY THAT
  HAS BEEN DEMANDING SPEEDY DE-STALINIZATION HAS NOT YET BEEN
  SILENCED BY NOVOTNY'S SHARP REPLY OF 12 JUNE. HE WILL PROBABLY
  HAVE TO USE STRONGER METHODS TO RESTORE PARTY DISCIPLINE.
