

THE PRESIDENT'S INTELLIGENCE CHECKLIST -- 31 SEPTEM

1. SOUTH VIETNAM:

- A. THE DIEM/NHU REGIME IS BUSILY TRYING TO SHARPEN UP ITS DESIRED IMAGE AS A UNITED NATION.
- B. "SPONTANEOUS" MASS RALLIES WERE STAGED TODAY IN SAIGON AND OTHER CITIES TO DEMONSTRATE THAT THE GOVERN-MENT AND ARMED FORCES ENJOY BROAD POPULAR SUPPORT. AMBASSADOR LODGE REPORTS THAT THE SAIGON DEMONSTRATION WAS ATTENDED BY A WELL-ORGANIZED BUT APATHETIC CROWD.
- C. THE ARMY HAS ALSO CHIPPED IN. GENERAL DINH,
 THE MILITARY GOVERNOR OF SAIGON, HAS PUBLICLY DENIED
 THAT DISSIDENCE EXISTS IN THE ARMED FORCES. THIS IS A
 FOLLOW-UP TO A RECENT STATEMENT FROM THE GENERAL STAFF
 ACCEPTING FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE MARTIAL LAW.
- D. REGIME PUBLICISTS ARE MAKING MUCH OF THE RE-LEASE OF THE MAJORITY OF RECENTLY ARRESTED STUDENTS AND BUDDHISTS AND OF THE MEETING BETWEEN DIEM AND THE "TRUE" BUDDHIST LEADERS.

E. USSR-YUGOSLAVIA: KHRUSHCHEV'S PROGRESS THROUGH YUGOSLAVIA HAS BEEN MARKED BY SIGNS THAT SUBSTANTIAL AD-VANCES HAVE BEEN MADE TOWARD THE RESOLUTION OF SOVIET—YUGOSLAV DIFFERENCES. WITH AN EYE COCKED TOWARD PEIPING, BOTH KHRUSHCHEV AND TITO HAVE BEEN LABORING THE IDEA OF CLOSE PARTY AND GOVERNMENT RELATIONS. TITO HAS ALSO REMARKED THAT THE "DYNAMIC" EXPANSION OF SOVIET-YUGOSLAV ECONOMIC RELATIONS "SHOULD COMPENSATE FOR WHAT HAS BEEN OMITTED IN THE PAST."
