5. NOTES:

- A. ARGENTINA: ILLIA LAST NIGHT ANNULLED THE OIL CONTRACTS. HIS DECREES CALL FOR THE TREASURY MINISTER TO PRESENT A REPORT ON THE OIL PROBLEM. THIS PRESUMABLY WILL SERVE AS A BASIS FOR A COMPENSATION SETTLEMENT TO BE DECIDED IN THE COURTS.
- B. CANADA-BULGARIA: CANADIAN ABILITY TO DELIVER ON THE WHEAT DEALS WITH EAST EUROPE IS BEING TAXED TO THE LIMIT. ALTHOUGH THE BULGARIANS HAVE BEEN PRESSING FOR DELIVERY OF 200,000 TONS BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR THE CANADIANS SAY THEY WILL HAVE TO WAIT UNTIL APRIL WHEN THE ST. LAWRENCE OPENS. OUR LEGATION IN SOFIA THINKS BULGARIA MAY SOON TRY TO GET WHEAT FROM THE US.
- C. UK: DENIS HEALEY, LABOR'S DEFENSE SPOKESMAN, HAS
 TOLD OUR EMBASSY THAT IF THE MLF PROPOSAL SURVIVES AND ALTERNATIVE COURSES REMAIN BLOCKED, THEN A LABOR GOVERNMENT WOULD
 FINALLY COME AROUND TO JOINING MLF RATHER THAN STAYING OUTSIDE. HE SAID THIS VIEW WAS SHARED BY HAROLD WILSON AND
 PATRICK GORDON WALKER ALTHOUGH FOR OBVIOUS REASONS IT COULD
 ONLY BE FOUND IN "SMALL PRINT" PARTY STATEMENTS ON GENERAL
 MLF POLICY.
- D. SOUTH KOREA: THE REGIME IS USING MORE POLICE PRESSURE IN THE CURRENT CAMPAIGN FOR THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY THAN IT DID IN LAST MONTH'S UNCOMFORTABLY CLOSE PRESIDENTIAL

ELECTIONS. IF THE POLICE GET TOO HEAVY-HANDED THERE COULD BE TROUBLE IN THE CLOSING DAYS OF THE CAMPAIGN, WHICH ENDS ON 26 NOVEMBER.

E. FRANCE - SOUTH VIETNAM: A FRENCH FOREIGN MINISTRY OFFICIAL HAS TOLD AMBASSADOR BOHLEN THERE IS REAL DISAGREE-MENT BETWEEN THE QUAI D'ORSAY AND DE GAULLE ON VIETNAMESE POLICY. HE SAID THAT DE GAULLE HAD FLATLY OVERRULED THE QUAI'S RECOMMENDATION THAT FRANCE IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZE THE NEW SOUTH VIETNAMESE GOVERNMENT. THE OFFICIAL SPECULATED THAT DE GAULLE WAS ATTEMPTING TO SHOW HIS INDEPENDENCE OF THE US, BUT THAT HE WAS ALSO ACTING ON A VAGUE BELIEF THAT SOME FORM OF NEGOTIATIONS MIGHT BE NECESSARY IN THE FUTURE.
