3. COMMUNIST CHINA - MEXICO:

- A. COMMUNIST CHINA HAS PLACED A \$28 MILLION ORDER FOR 200,000 BALES OF MEXICAN COTTON FOR DELIVERY DURING 1964, ACCORDING TO AN ANNOUNCEMENT BY CHINESE OFFICIALS VISITING MEXICO.
- B. THIS CONTRACT WOULD ACCOUNT FOR ABOUT 20 PERCENT OF MEXICO'S ANTICIPATED 1964 COTTON EXPORTS. ASIDE FROM CHINA'S 1963 PURCHASES OF WHEAT-ABOUT \$18 MILLION-SINO-MEXICAN TRADE 50X1 HAS BEEN INSIGNIFICANT.

- 5. ITALY-FRANCE: PRESIDENT SEGNI WILL MAKE A STATE VISIT TO PARIS FEBRUARY 19-22. PRESS REPORTS FROM PARIS THIS MORN-ING SAY DE GAULLE ALSO HOPES TO MEET WITH ERHARD IN FEBRUARY.
- 6. USSR: KHRUSHCHEV HAS GIVEN UPI CORRESPONDENT HENRY SHAPIRO A STATEMENT ANSWERING QUESTIONS ON "PROSPECTS FOR PEACE IN 1964." WHILE THE TEXT WE HAVE CONTAINS NO NEW PROPOSALS, THE TONE CONTINUES TO BE FRIENDLY TOWARD THE UNITED STATES AND PRESIDENT JOHNSON.
- 7. GREECE: FINANCIER JOHN PARASKEVOPOULOS HAS BEEN ASKED
 TO FORM A CARETAKER CABINET. THE NEW NATIONAL ELECTION WILL
 PROBABLY BE HELD IN EARLY FEBRUARY.
