IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties, through their respective counsel, that the time for the hearing on the motions for summary judgment be continued from June 5, 1978, at 9:00 A.M., to ~~August 21~~ ^{SEPT 5}, 1978, at 9:00 A.M., and the trial now set for July 18, 1978, at 9:00 A.M., be continued to October 31, 1978, at 9:00 A.M.

The reason for this continuance is that the parties have agreed that a favorable result in plaintiff's criminal trial, presently set for May 15, 1978, in the Los Angeles County Superior Court, may obviate any further necessity for this suit. Judge Earl Riley has declined to continue the trial of the Los

1 Angeles Superior Court action entitled People v. Woolbright,
2 Case No. A 316 449, so that motions for summary judgment may be
3 heard in this suit prior to the trial of that state action.
4 Therefore, any prejudice which will accrue to Mr. Woolbright
5 as a result of not having relevant Central Intelligence Agency
6 information will happen regardless of whether this matter is
7 heard on June 5, 1978, or later.

8 Accordingly, this continuance is requested in an effort to
9 avoid further litigation in this case.


