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which would bring him the necessary funds to effect the transfer, and that these funds should be entrusted to the group's leader (L) ~~Brooks~~ <sup>W. B.</sup>.

- b) TUDJMAN is said to accompany his group to a house in the country (location unknown) where the members will be reconditioned physically, and where they will prepare for the journey ahead of them. GJEVAROVIC does not know whether the group will proceed to Yugoslavia from Italy or whether it will travel via Austria.

c) It is reported that Ljubomir MAMČIĆ (35 years old, ex-employee of the Croatian Secretariat of State for Security and Public Order) will remain as a member of the group, but first he wishes to assure himself that the enterprise is favorably regarded by the Americans.

d) A youth who has confessed to membership in the group is Dragiša KERKOVIC (20 years old, a housepainter by trade) who is furious because of CUPRIVIĆ's rather disregardful treatment of security.

e) Miroslav VASILJEVIĆ (a functionary of the short-lived 1943 TITO-partisan administration of SLOVENIA) recently changed his mind about leaving with the group as he had previously intended; he is aware, however, of the project as it is outlined here. VASILJEVIĆ is a friend of Stevana KUŠMIĆ who is undoubtedly a British agent, but is of such doubtful moral character that he would be quite capable of collaborating with OZBILJ.

f) A sixth individual, Feđo JAKOŠEVIĆ (age 30), politically reliable from the anti-Communist point of view, has also reversed a previous decision to be a member of the departing group.

**VII. -PROPOSAL TO Establish Liaison with CEN**

## 32. Invincible Fleet to the American Frigates

It has been determined that Dr. Kraszalay's DIAUICUVIC is in contact with at least one member of the American Embassy in Rome to whom he furnishes reports on Croatian affairs. These reports are compiled on the basis of information which DIAUICUVIC gathers from refugees escaping from Yugoslavia. It is felt that DIAUICUVIC's reports on the Yugoslav internal situation, similar to certain predictions he made, reflect his own profound disillusion in the field of political science rather than current reality. Valuable from the academic point of view of analysis and interpretation of certain facts and trends, his reports undoubtedly fail short of presenting a true picture of current situation & opposition in Croatia.

### 33. DIAGNOSTIC APPROXIMATING MARKS AND SIGNS.

Recently DRAGOVIC has attempted to establish a contact with local CRU  
agents; probably because his American February acquaintance has requested  
information as to Croatian resistance activities, and his naturally turned  
to KROSTNER. Tim Lintir, [REDACTED] "soviat robin."  
Lately he tried to inform DRAGOVIC that a quite well-organized CRU actually  
exists. It was felt necessary to extend the degree of confidence to  
DRAGOVIC in order to assure that the latter would not in any way impede  
the Italy-Austria flow of personnel necessary for our cause.

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Therefore, the only valid CIV information which DRAGOVIC can now supply to his American military contact are those furnished him by MUSIGROVE. The latter, in turn, will not submit any material to DRAGOVIC without first consulting with [REDACTED] and obtaining his approval. Thus unless the informant ridiculous situation in which [REDACTED] submits to another (DRAGOVIC's) [REDACTED] materials which might be considered as "chicken feed".

#### VIII. unidentified American Agency in Austria Works Through CIV Contact.

##### 35. DRAGOVIC Authority to Contact MUSIGROVE.

As regards its eventual significance, the case of Herber X DENTRICH may be considered analogous to that of DRAGOVIC. DENTRICH, an American stationed with an American unit in Vienna, has recently been in Koen, apparently for the express purpose of contacting MUSIGROVE in an effort to obtain information on the CIV.

##### 36. [REDACTED] Every Month Perform "Security Check" on DENTRICH.

A recent letter from State MIKOVIC requests [REDACTED] to submit an opinion as to the background and reliability of DENTRICH, which would indicate that DENTRICH is in contact with the CIV's Austrian representatives. Once again [REDACTED] is a point of [REDACTED] control over the operations of another [REDACTED]. It can logically be surmised that the type, amount and quality of information supplied to DENTRICH by the DRH in Austria will depend on [REDACTED] advice.

#### IX. PERMAR and the Independent U.S. Resistance Movement.

##### 37. "American Contact" of JESIK-JUKIĆ.

A third similar situation arises in the case of Post (Reverend Father) Pavle JESIK and Painter (or Parko) JUKIĆ who are allegedly in contact with a high-ranking American officer. JUKIĆ arrived in Rome from Split (Split) for the purpose of informing (Dr.) Ivan ŠIMIĆ of U.S. organization in the District of Split and its participation in the Croatian Resistance. JUKIĆ placed JESIK in contact with JESIK who considers himself a loyal U.S. representative, but who is morally a good and honest priest completely innocent of any consideration of political realities. [REDACTED] has been acquainted with JESIK for at least twelve years).

##### 38. JUKIĆ to Return to Yugoslavia.

Through JUKIĆ, the father of the idea, and JESIK it is to be demonstrated to the Americans that U.S., too, controls an independent resistance organization within Croatia. To implement this project JUKIĆ must be returned to Croatia from whence he will maintain a contact with JESIK and the American officer mentioned above. The only factor in which JUKIĆ can return and activate his contact, however, is by seeking the aid of the CIV organization represented in Rome by MUSIGROVE.

##### 39. MUSIGROVE Delays MIKE Mission.

In the meantime MUSIGROVE is deliberately delaying the return of MIKE because certain elements in the latter's case leave some doubt as to his

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
