Delegates from Europe and South America are, according to Father Grubusic's paper, coming to the February 27 Ustashi Congress. DANICA of February 2, on Page 2, refers to the European delegate as "an honorable old man" and to the South American delegates as one whose arrival will be a "first class sensation". Dr. Peshell believes that the European delegate is (Professor) Filip Lukas, who has long been connected with the Pavelich Ustashi organization and is presently reported to be a DP in the British Zone in Austria. The South American delegate is most likely (Father) Krunoslav Draganovic, and Ustashi priest who found sanctuary in the St. Jerome monastery in Rome and who, to the Department's own knowledge, has been most active and instrumental in serving as liaison between the Vatican and the Ustashi, and in assisting the Pavelich supporters to emigrate to Argentina, where a great number of them now are. He is said to have gone to the Argentine with Pavelich. Two other Ustashi in Europe who might possibly apply for visas to attend this Ustashi congress are (Professor) Julije Kriskovic, said to be in Zurich and Dr. Branko Jelio, in London.
