REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 30 November 1952, Professor Vojislav M. **POPOVIC**, born 22 July 1907 in Radljevo, Yugoslavia, Yugoslav (Serbian) refugee, residing at Schwimmschulstrasse 5, Salzburg, was interviewed in the Serbo-Croatian language by the undersigned Agent and stated essentially as follows:

During World War II, **SUBJECT** was a confidential agent of the Ustaša and served directly under Ante **DVINO**, notorious wartime Ustaša leader in Croatia. **SUBJECT** was also an official Croatian Government press attaché in Berlin, Germany, during World War II. His special assignment in Germany during this time was to maintain liaison with various Croatian workers in Germany for the purpose of disseminating Ustaša propaganda to them. **SUBJECT**, as Dr. Stjepan **TOMKOZO**, wrote numerous articles for the **Novi List** (Croatian People), a Croatian language newspaper which was distributed in Yugoslavia during World War II and the official organ of the Ustaša. The following issues of the aforementioned publication in which **SUBJECT** wrote of his Nazi and Ustaša participations may be found in the Austrian Government archives in Vienna, Austria:

Issue No. 1018, dated 25 April 1944, carried a by-line article by **SUBJECT** in which he acknowledged that he collaborated with the Nazi's and that he made inspection tours of Croatian Army units with leading Croatian Government and Ustaša officials.

Issue No. 1056, dated 11 June 1944, carried a by-line article by **SUBJECT** in which he acknowledged that he interrogated US and British war prisoners in German POW camps.

Issue No. 1090, dated 23 July 1944, carried an article which stated that **SUBJECT** was directed by the German Army to interrogate Archbishop Alois **STEFANIG**, prelate of the Roman Catholic Church in Yugoslavia, for remarks he made against the Nazi's.

Issue No. 1201, dated 1 December 1944, and Issue No. 1203, dated 3 December 1944, carried by-line articles by **SUBJECT** in which he acknowledged that he interrogated a high ranking general officer who was held prisoner by the German Army SS troops in Yugoslavia.

After the fall of Germany during World War II, **SUBJECT** came to Innsbruck, Land Tyrol, Austria. While residing in Innsbruck, **SUBJECT** continued his Ustaša activities and associated with former Ustaša agents. He organized a pro-Tito Yugoslav National Committee in Innsbruck and it was rumored that **SUBJECT** wore a uniform with a large red star during this time, but the alleg-

tion was never satisfactorily proven to be a fact. It was definitely established that he maintained his former Ustasha ties. On 9 July 1945, SUBJECT left Innsbruck and came to City Salzburg. He immediately contacted the various heads of the Roman Catholic Church in City Salzburg; this event made evident the fact that the Ustasha and the Vatican Intelligence were working together. During this period (1945) one Father (fma) DRAGANOVIC, who sided with the Ustasha during the war in Yugoslavia, came to the Vatican and subsequently resided at Rome, via: Marulana, Italy. It was known that SUBJECT associated with DRAGANOVIC during this time. SUBJECT soon gained prominence in Roman Catholic Church activities in City Salzburg and married a woman who was either the daughter or near relative of Dr. Gustav Adolf CARNYAL, of the managing staff of the *Salzburger Nachrichten* (daily newspaper published in the German language in City Salzburg). Immediately following the marriage, SUBJECT wrote news articles for the aforementioned news publication concerning Austrian political and economic issues under the name of Alfons DALIĆ, and gradually became a highly regarded journalist in Austria and a member of the *Nachrichten's* editing staff. He has also written articles which have criticized the US.

SUBJECT is still a leading figure among the Croats in Austria and continues to maintain his ties in a far-reaching intelligence network which is headed by Ante PAVIĆIĆ. In discussions, SUBJECT openly defended the Ustasha and its atrocious deeds in Yugoslavia. He maintains close liaison with the Croatian Caritas in Salzburg; this organization is completely controlled by the Roman Catholic Church and several former members of the Ustasha. The Croatian Caritas is an operational base for Vatican agents and Ustasha activities. The Croatian Caritas has been used as a "cover" by the Vatican intelligence agency in City Salzburg, since it is able to obtain travel permits and visas for travel to almost any country in the world through this medium.

SUBJECT is definitely a Vatican intelligence operative. He makes frequent trips to Rome, Italy, and has been observed at various Roman Catholic Church conferences at the Vatican. He presently maintains very close relations with Archbishop ROHRACHER, Roman Catholic Church prelate in Salzburg. Archbishop ROHRACHER formed the Vatican intelligence agency in Land Salzburg and now directs its activities. (0-9)

Source stated that he received the information in this report through his close affiliation with the Royalist Yugoslav intelligence sources in Austria, through correspondence, and through personal observations and research.
